Nkọwa nke Ndụ Ebighi Ebi	Definition of Eternal Life
Jon 3:36 Onye kwere n'Okpara ahu nwere ndu ebighi-ebi: ma onye nēkweghi na Okpara ahu agaghi-ahu ndu, kama iwe Chineke nānōgide n'aru-ya.	John 3:36 He that believes on the Son has eternal life, but he who does not believe on the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."
Àgwà anyị n'ebe Kraịst nọ ma ọ bụ ekweghi ekwe na-ekpebi ma anyị nwere ndụ ebighi ebi.	Our attitude toward Christ belief or unbelief determines whether we have eternal life.
Okwu Grik PISTEUO nke di ugbu a na-eme ka i nweta ndụ ebighi ebi n'oge i kwenyere na i ka na-enweta ya.	The Greek word PISTEUO in the present tense means you have eternal life the moment you believe and you continue to have it.
Mmadu nwere ndu ebighiebi mgbe o kwere na Onyenwe anyi Jisos Kraist dika Onye nzoputa ya. A na-akpọ onye a onye kwere ekwe.	A person has eternal life the moment he believes in the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Savior. This person is also called a believer.

Atọ nke Ndụ Ebighi Ebi	Three Categories of Eternal Life
Maka onye kwere ekwe na Jisos Kraist onye nwuru tupu oge abia nke Jisos Kraist nke a mara dika mbilite n'onwu nke ndi kwere ekwe nime Kraist, enwere uzo ato nke ndu ebighiebi.	For the believer in Jesus Christ who dies prior to the second coming of Jesus Christ also known as the resurrection of the believers in Christ, there are three categories of eternal life.
1. Onye kwere ekwe nwere ndu ebighiebi mgbe o na-ebi n'elu ala, inwe ndu nke uwa na ndu ebighiebi.	1. The believer has eternal life while living on the earth, having both earthly and eternal life.
2. Onye kwere ekwe nwere ndu ebighi ebi mgbe onwu gasiri mgbe o biri n'elu igwe na ichere nbilite n'onwu ya. Nke a nwere ike nkewa di ka inwe ndu ogologo oge na ndu ebighi ebi.	2. The believer has eternal life after death while living in heaven and waiting for his resurrection body. This can be classified as having both interim life and eternal life.
Onye kwere ekwe nwere ndu ebighiebi ruo mgbe ebighi ebi n 'aru nke nbilite n'onwu, nke bu ndu nbilite n'onwu na ndu ebighiebi.	3. The believer has eternal life forever in a resurrection body, which is resurrection life and eternal life.

The interim life and eternal life stage makes no distinction between winners and losers in the Christian life. It provides supreme happiness for every believer.

Mbilite n'ọnụwụ na ndụ ebighi ebi nwere ahụ mbilite n'ọnụwụ.	Resurrection life plus eternal life has the resurrection body.

Therefore, eternal life exists in two or more categories of life. The person who does not die experiences two categories of eternal life; the person who does die experiences three categories of eternal life.
Mmadu nwere ike inweta ndụ ebighi ebi naanị mgbe ọ dị ndụ n'ụwa.	A person can obtain eternal life only while he is alive on earth..
Mmadu apughị inweta ndụ ebighi ebi mgbe ọ nwurụrụ dị ka onye na-ekweghị na Jizọs Kraịst.	A person cannot get eternal life once he dies as an unbeliever in Jesus Christ.
Ndụ ebighi ebi malitere n'oge ndụ onye kwere ekwe.	Eternal life begins during a believer's lifetime.

Jon 3:18 "Onye na-ekwere na Ya ka a gaghị ama ya ikpe; ma onye na-ekweghị na a mara ya ikpe ugbo a, n'ihia na o kweghị n'aha nke Ọkpara Chineke mụrụ naanị ya.	John 3:18 "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
Ndụ ebighi ebi bụ naanị onye kwere ekwe nke na-enweghị ahụ. Ị nwere ahụ na ndụ ebighi ebi gị.	Eternal life belongs only to the believer who is never without a body. You always have a body with your eternal life.
